‘It’s true then,’ said Buck Rabbit.

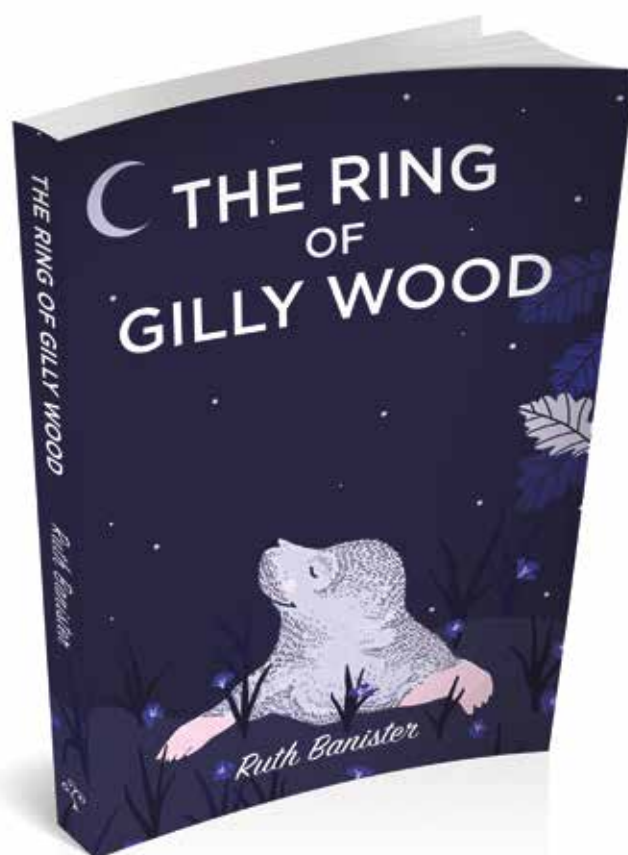
‘He’s just a small mole,’ said Doe Rabbit.
