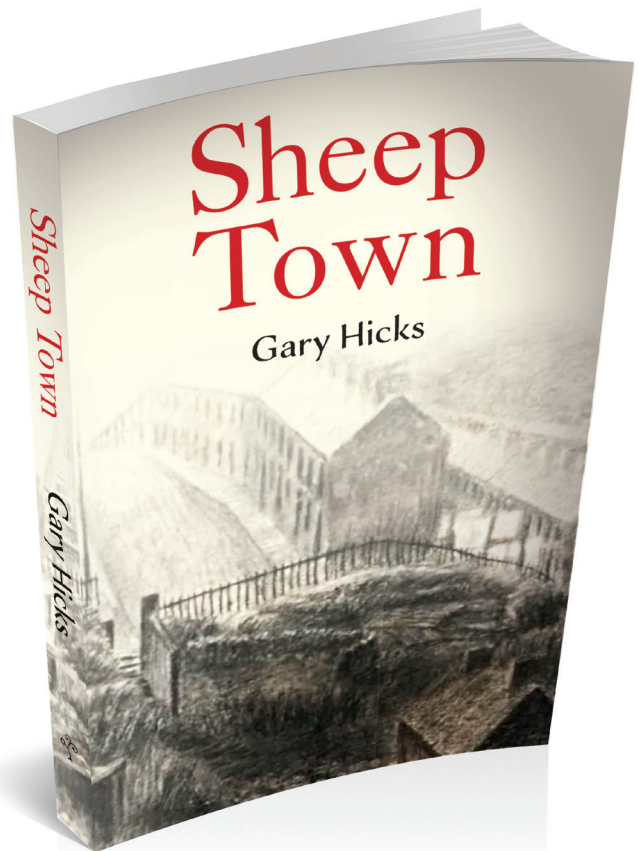


Sheep Town

About the book

For years a reactionary Labour Party has dominated Treorchan, a grim mining town thrust high in the South Wales Valleys. But now, in 1966, change is coming with the election to the local council of Errigal Keerog as sole Liberal representative.

He is determined to challenge the comrades' monopoly of power. They clash on many issues: the sheep that plague the town, the invasion of hippies, the sinister nocturnal activities. Sometimes Errigal wins, sometimes the Stalinists.

Things come to a head with Errigal's declaration of independence, a move that brings both MI5 and the KGB scurrying to the isolated town.
