When unassuming college lecturer Greg Stewart finds a code in the pocket of a second-hand waistcoat it leads him to the code's instigator...murdered in his home.

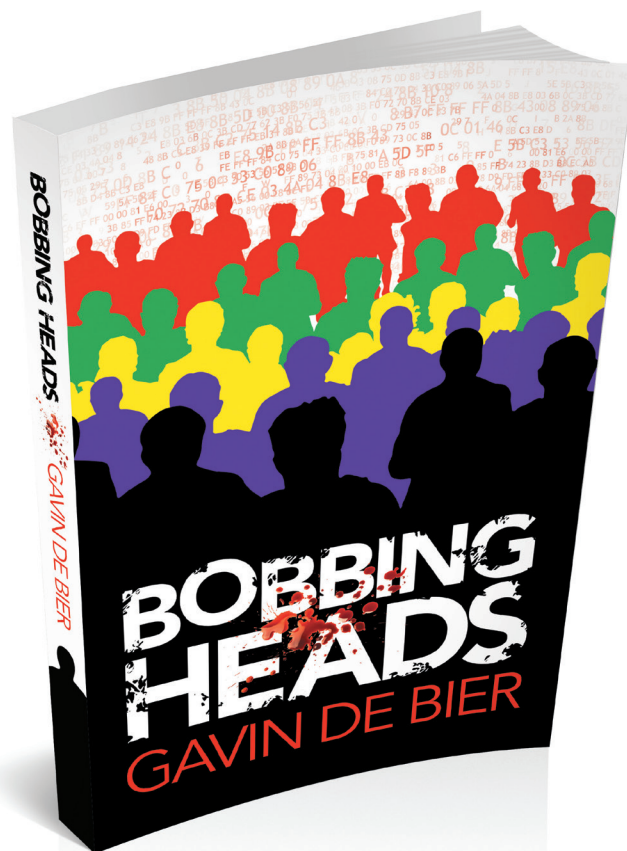
