About the book

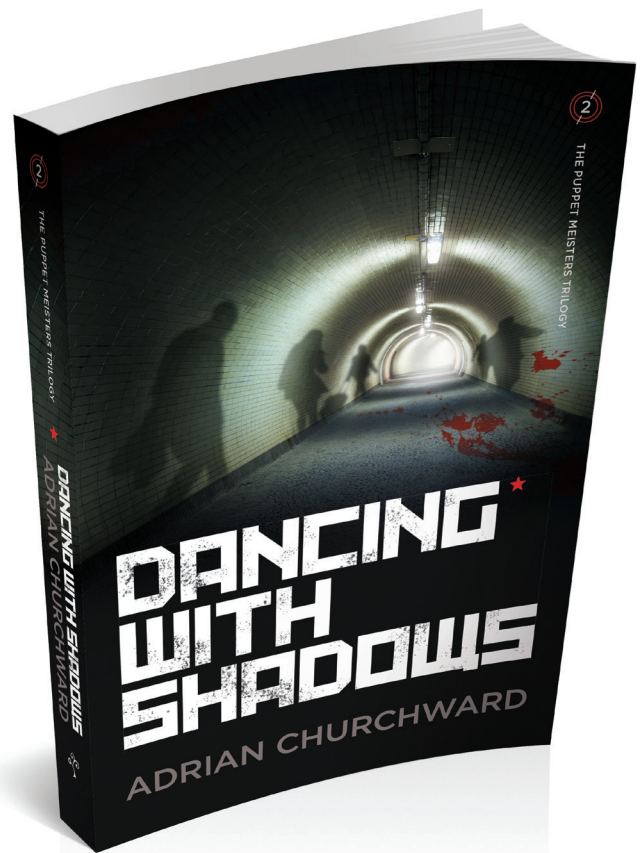
