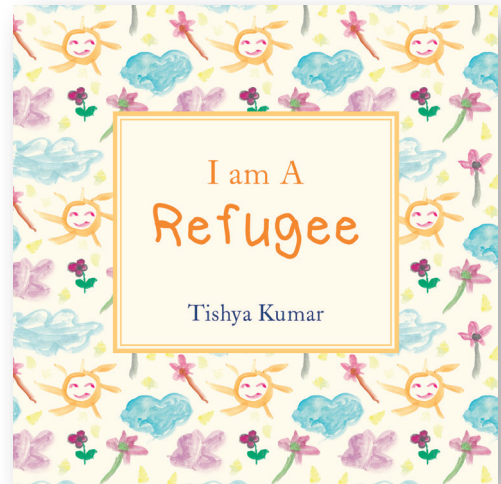


I am A Refugee
