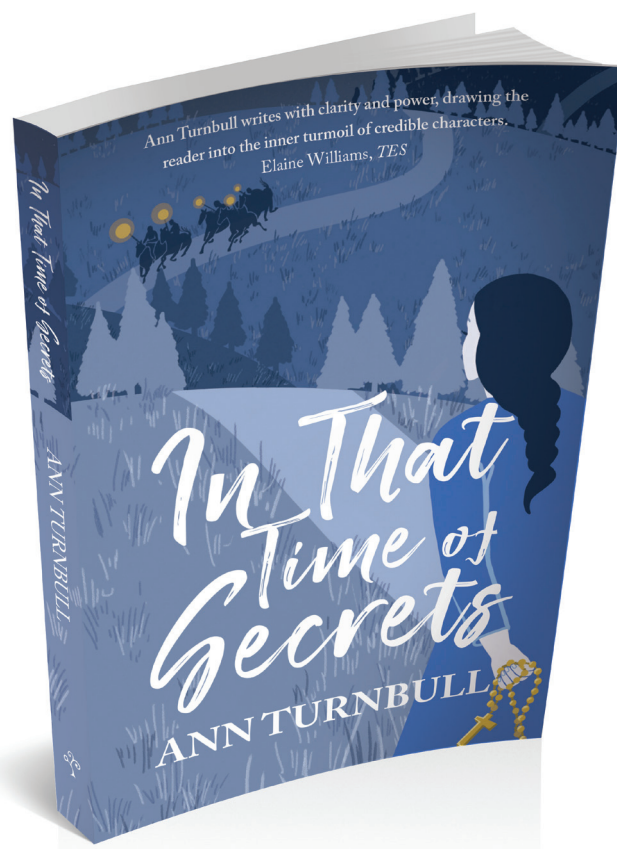
But nothing at Lyde Hall is what it seems. Who is David? And what dangerous secrets is Rob hiding?
