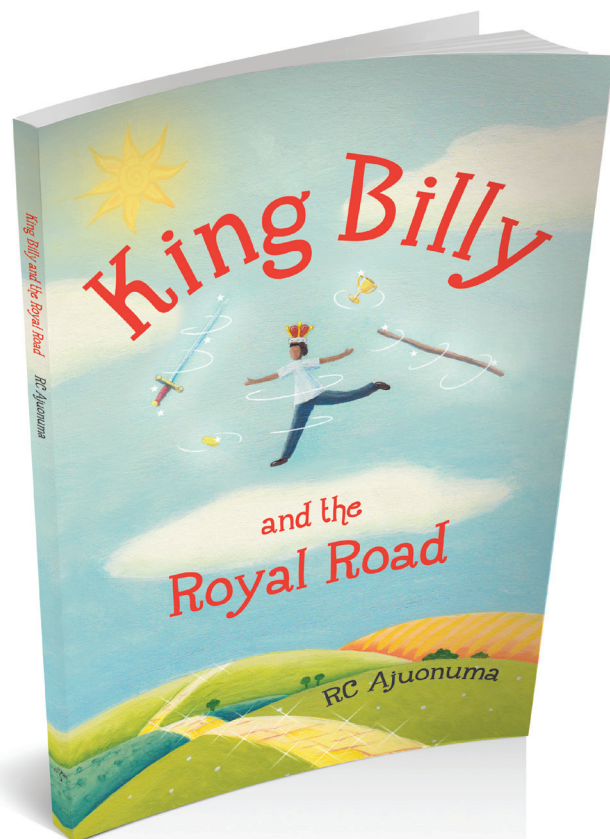


# King Billy and the Royal Road
