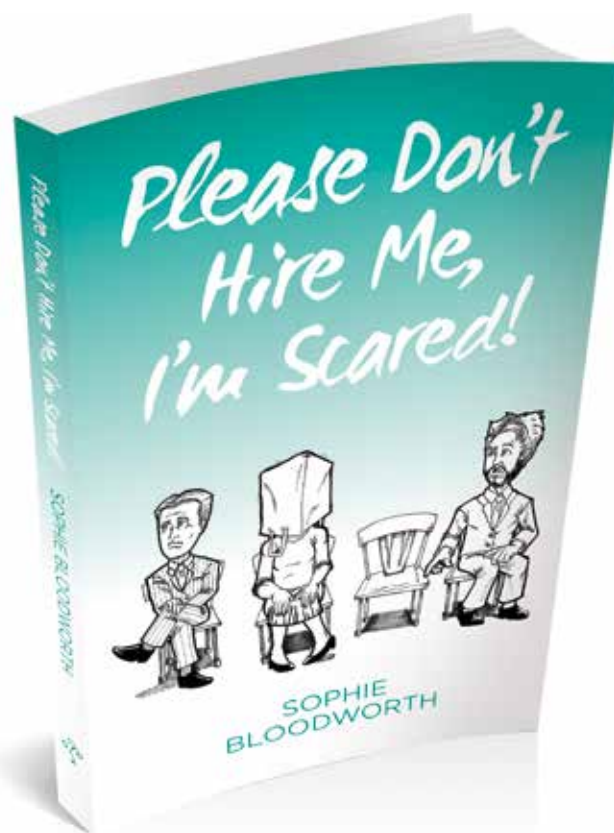


Please Don't Hire Me, I'm Scared!
