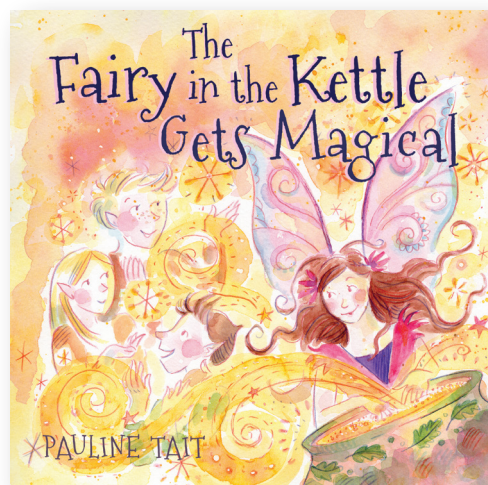

The Fairy in the Kettle gets magical in this new adventure!

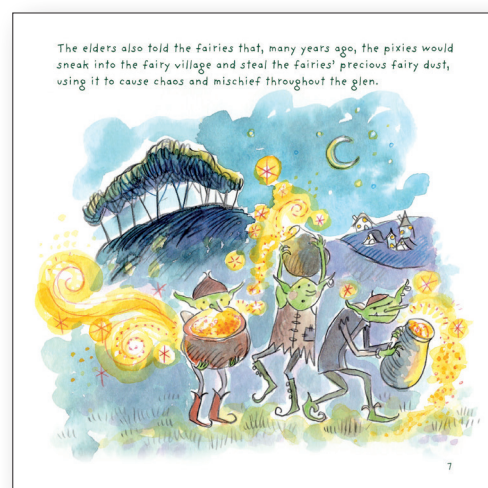
“They could remember its warm amber glow shimmering and sparkling as it danced through the air, twisting and turning as it went.”
