About the book


The story of Woodford County High School has been written to coincide with the centenary of the School. Founded in 1919, in the troubled aftermath of war, its history mirrors the time in which it grew and developed.

Seen through the eyes of young girls over the last century, it's possible to glimpse the world in which they grew up; the customs of the day, their schooling, their hopes and expectations and ambitions for their futures.

Although it has a special relevance to those associated with the School, either as pupils or staff, the history will appeal to those with an interest in local and social history. Written by former pupil Rosemary Davis, the history is derived from the writings and opinions of girls and teachers whose visions of girlhood exist in the School's magazine archive.

About the author

Rosemary Davis worked as a PA in Nantes and London before taking up a career in teaching. In retirement, she has been involved in cataloguing materials in the School's Archive, which includes a full set of School magazines from its early years.
