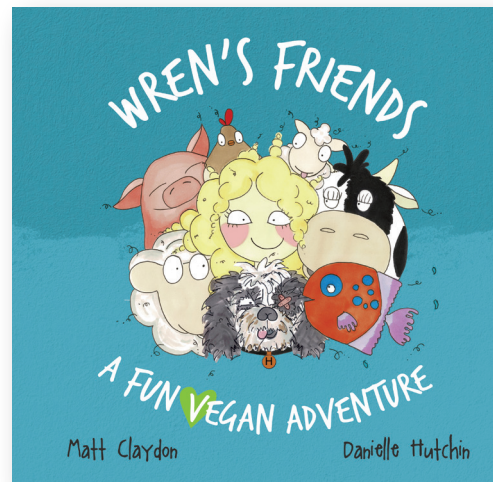

Meet Humphrey – he's a one-eyed, scruffy Shi-Tsu.

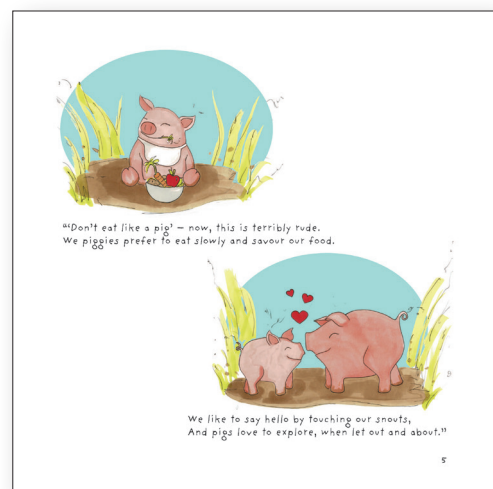
Let them introduce you to some pretty special friends that all live to love life: the playful pig, the caring cow, the shy sheep, the friendly fish and chilled-out chickens.
